SR 32 Improvements, Eastgate Area Project Update

Ramps Open This Week

As improvement work continues at the I-275/SR 32 Interchange, ODOT has announced that the new ramp from Eastgate Boulevard to Eastbound (EB) SR 32 was officially opened to traffic as of Wednesday, November 12.

The existing ramps to Westbound SR 32 from Eastgate Boulevard and Eastgate North Drive will reopen today. This will end the detour to Gleneste-Withamsville Road via Eastgate North Drive. All the turn lanes on Eastgate Boulevard and the Eastgate North Drive will be open by this evening.

Temporary Lane Closure Tonight

- Beginning at 7 p.m. tonight, November 14, traffic on EB SR 32 will be reduced to one lane as painting work on the Eastgate Boulevard bridge over SR 32 is completed. One lane of traffic will continue until Monday, November 24, at 2 p.m.

Significant Work Will Be Complete by Thanksgiving

Weather permitting, by Thanksgiving, the continuous flow ramp from NB I-275 to EB SR 32 through the newly-built tunnel, will open. This new ramp will reduce traffic moving through the primary I-275/SR 32 interchange area and improve the traffic flow going to Eastgate Boulevard and support better movements for traffic moving west to Newtown.

After the ramp through the tunnel is open, ODOT will continue to monitor traffic signal timing at the I-275/SR 32 ramps to ensure traffic is moving efficiently, and will make adjustments as needed.
